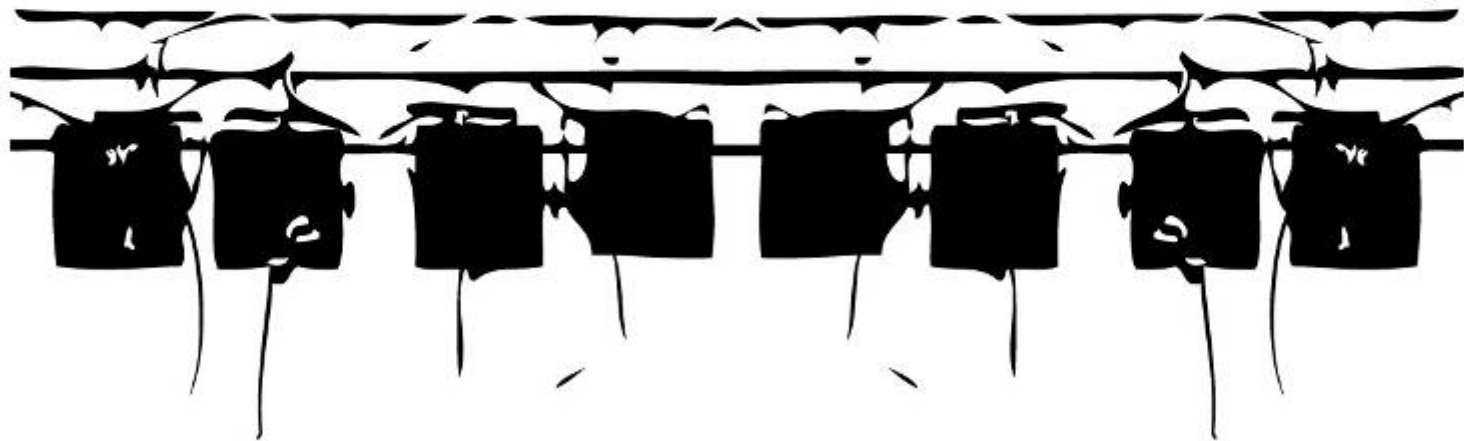

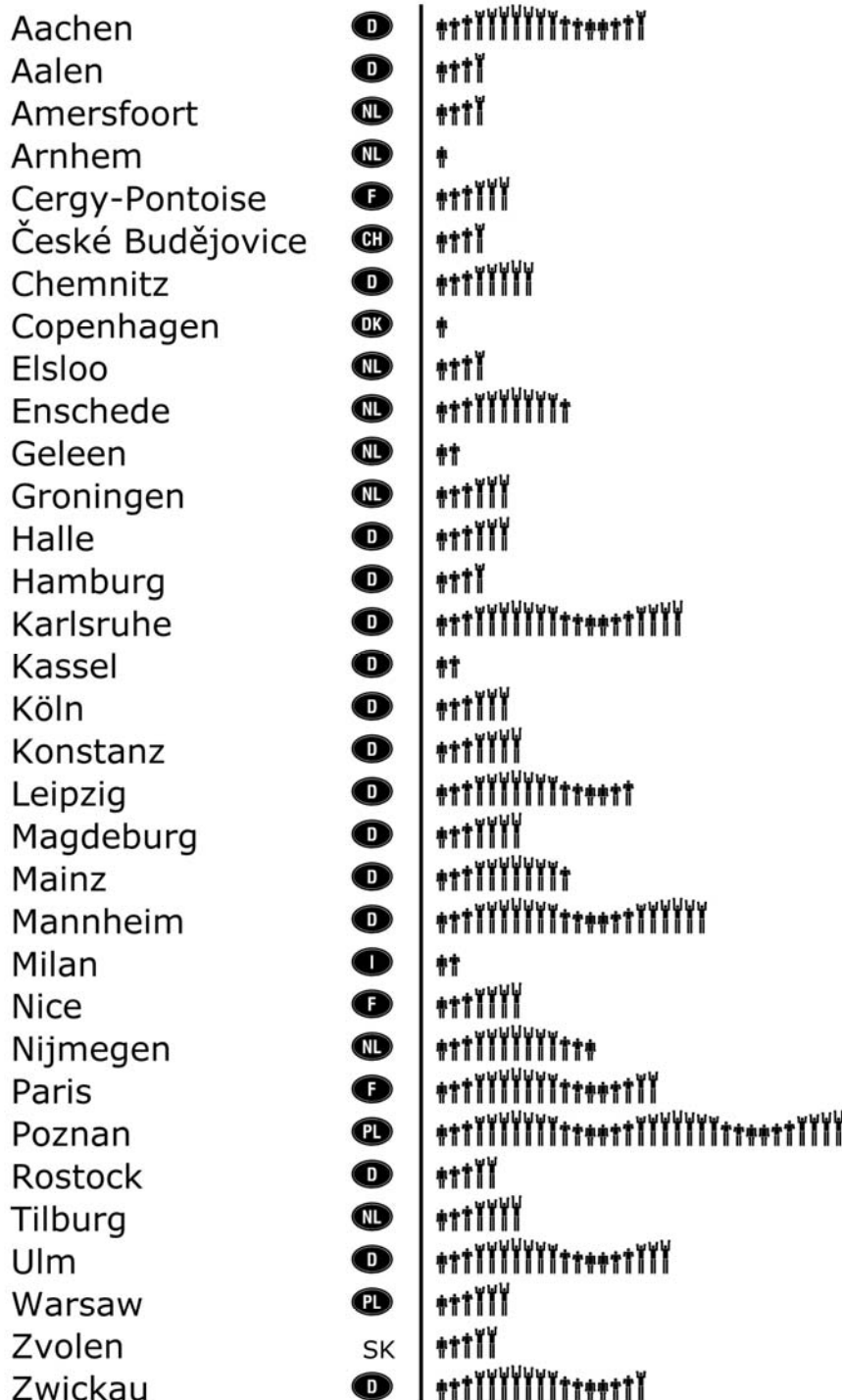

While the participants are enjoying themselves, the tournament committee starts making the team tournament schedules.

- 17.15 Finals of the men team tournament.
- 18.00 Dinnertime. Take a look at the map to find your way in Eindhoven.
- 21.00-?? The big ITT party at The Choir in the bunker. We hope you will go there and if so you will have a great time there. With the famous band Vintage '79!!!

Sunday, May 9th

- 7.30 Time to get up. ^Maurice our DJ from hell will wake you with some even more sick horrible sounds.
- 8.00-9.30 Breakfast.
- 9.30 Start of the individual tournament. Be in time!
- 11.30-12.00 Lunchtime. (open 11.30h-13.30h)
- 15:15 Semi-finals of the ladies individual tournament.
- 15.30 Semi-finals of the men individual tournament.
- 16.00 Finals of the ladies individual tournament.
- 16.15 Finals of the men individual tournament.
- 17.00 Presentation of prizes and the end of this year's ITT.

Tournament Rules

In the ITT every competitor has a chance to reach the main final. Since we have so many competitors, it's important that we start all the matches on time: at 9:00 on Saturday and at 9:30 on Sunday. For further matches always make sure to be at the table at the time indicated on your personal overview, which you get at the information desk in the morning starting at 8:30.

All matches are played best of five. The rules of the Dutch Table Tennis Federation (NTTB) will be followed, which can be viewed (in Dutch) at the match table.

There are organizers present in every hall. They will provide you with balls for your matches or for practice. **Please return the ball to them when you are finished with it**; don't leave it at the table. You can also hand in the filled in match sheets to them.

Saturday

Each match in the team tournament on Saturday consists of two singles and one double. The singles matches are to be played first, and **the doubles match is played only if the score is 1-1 after these**. This applies even in the group phase of the men's tournament! However, in the group phase of the women's team tournament the doubles match is always played.

If you parked your car on the campus of the University you received a ticket at the boom barrier. It is possible to exchange this ticket for a drive-out card. In this way it is much cheaper to park your car, service of the ITT. One drive-out card costs you only EUR 2,50. The number of drive-out cards is limited, so please; don't drive in and out of the campus again and again.



Weather forecast

While producing this booklet during Palm Sunday, we obviously cannot precisely predict the weather during the ITT. However, we can give some boundaries.

- The temperature will be between: $-0,2^{\circ}\text{C}$ (1973) (esp. Important for the people sleeping in tents) and $30,5^{\circ}\text{C}$ (1943).
- It can either be very sunny, maximum of 14,9 hours of sun (1982) or very rainy, up to 18,9 hours of rain (1935), or anything in between.
- Typical average wind speeds in May in the Netherlands can reach up to 11,3 m/s (1915). Keep this in mind when you want to play at the outdoor table!!!
- In the Netherlands in 1997 the last snowflakes felt on May 7th, so don't be surprised when there is some snow during the ITT. It is just one week later!!

Map

Because you are reading this booklet right now, we can be very certain you have found at least one location of the map already, the location of the tournament.

On Saturday night there will be another very important location, the location of the party. Just like last year the party will be situated at the “Bunker”. If you have not been here last year, just follow the river, against it flowing direction and you will come at least near the “Bunker”.

If you get hungry, or thirsty, you might want to the supermarket. There are two supermarkets close to each other: the Aldi, famous for their flat bread of previous years and opposite, the slightly more expensive Albert Heijn. If you don't make it on time, don't worry, the night store is on the route to the supermarkets.

Every year some stupid donkeys lose this page. The people of TAVERES are always very friendly to these losers. But this year they will have a problem. **No tickets means no food!**

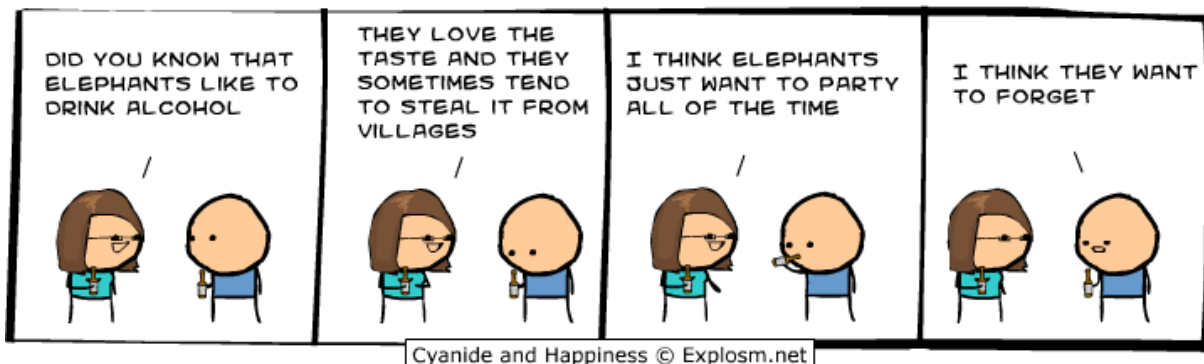
Important!!!

The flying pins



The Flying Pins Artwork is located at the southern end of the John F. Kennedylaan, the street between the Sportcentre and the Bunker, the location of the party. The artwork has been design by Claes Oldenburg and Coosje van Bruggen and was first exposed on May

31st 2000.

The artwork is a bowling ball with ten cones because the artists thought of the Kennedylaan as a big bowling lane. The ball and cones represented the erection and development of Eindhoven, which was ones surrounded by five other towns (which are now part of Eindhoven). The yellow color represents the yellow daffodils flowering along the Kennedylaan every spring. The artwork measures 9 meters in height and cost about 1,1 million euro's, paid by the local companies.

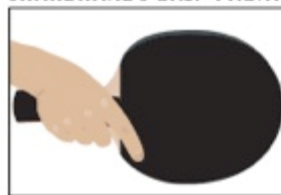
How to hold your paddle?

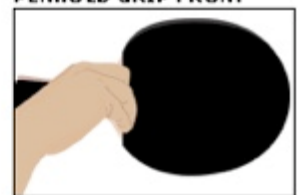

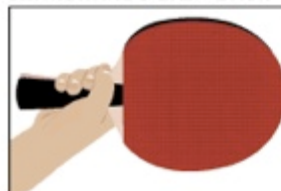
SHAKEHANDS GRIP FRONT



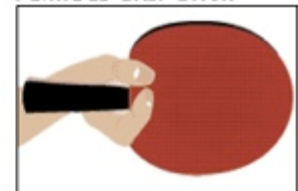
PENHOLD GRIP FRONT

Die Geheime Frühstück Plänen

Diesen Bericht schreibe ich im (schlechtes) Deutsch in die Hoffnung dass die Mitarbeiter vom Sportzentrum es nicht lesen können. Sie dürfen nicht wissen was wir geplant haben wenn die uns verbieten wurden dass wir unsere selbst geschmierte Brötchen für das Frühstück nicht an unsere ITT Teilnehmer ausgeben dürften.

Das aufbereiten vom Frühstück ist ein von die heiligste Ritualen von TAVERES. Die Verbundenheit die entsteht wenn die Freiwillige TAVERES Mitglieder von 6:30 bis 7:30 die Brötchen schmieren ist kritisch für die gute Zusammenarbeit für das folgende Jahr. Ohne dieses Ritual wurde TAVERES nicht mehr dieselbe sein. Es ist voraus gesehen das TAVERES wahrscheinlich innerhalb von ein Jahr zerfallen wurde.

Es wurde ein Plan aufgestellt um die Untergang von TAVERES zu vermeiden. Dass Plan sieht wie folgt aus:

- Samstag um 1:00 wird im Geheim ein Zelt auf den Camping aufgebaut.
- Ab 2: 00 wird durch ein Team die Brötchen Beutel, Käse, Schinken und Cervelaat zum Zelt gebracht. Es ist wichtig das alles unter die Jacken von diese ‚Lieferanten‘ passt so dass nicht entdeckt wird was Sie zum Zelt bringen.
- Von 6:30 bis 7:30 werden im Zelt durch die heilige Freiwillige die Brötchen geschmiert. Ein Spezialen Team wird auf die andere Seite vom Camping Aufgestellt. Dort werden Sie tun als ob Sie besoffen sind und müssen so probieren um die Sicherheitsdienst von der Universität ab zu lenken. Zur erwarten ist das diese Teammitglieder sich Opfern müssen durch Sich durch die Sicherheitsdienst verhaften zu lassen.
- Ab 8:00 werden TAVERES Freiwillige, eins für eins, die ITT Teilnehmer zum Zelt bringen. Die Teilnehmer haben maximal ein Minute die Zeit um die heilige Brötchen zu essen. Es müssen verschieden Maßnahmen getroffen werden um zu vermeiden das die Zelt durch die Mitarbeiter vom Sportzentrum oder die Sicherheitsdienst entdeckt wird:
 - Jeder halbe Stunde muss den Zelt verschoben und mit Farbe sollte die Farbe vom Zelt geändert werden.

- Teilnehmer die probieren den Zelt mit ungegessenen Brötchen zu verlassen müssen festgebunden und gefüttert werden. Es ist wichtig das kein Brötchen den Zelt ungegessen verlassen. Die Teilnehmer sollte aber auch ausreichende gegessen haben bevor Sie im Turnier spielen.
- Nachdem alle Teilnehmer gegessen haben wird den Zelt zum letzen mall verschoben und lehr geräumt. Auch hier muss beachtet werden dass niemand sieht was den Zelt verlässt. Die gleiche Strategie von denn Nacht davor sollte auch tagsüber funktionieren.
- Das vorbereiten vom Mittagessen hat nicht den gleichen Ritualen Einfluss wie das Bereiten vom Frühstück. Die Sportzentrummitarbeit sollte darum das Mittagessen Versorgen. Damit wird das Sportzentrum auf den Falschen Bein gestellt so dass Sie denken dass weiter nichts los ist.
- Sonntag kann das gleiche plan ausgeführt werden wie Samstag außerhalb das am Ende vom Dienst alle Beweise vernichtet werden müssen. Das verbrennen vom Zelt mit alle Beweisen ist eine gute Methode.

Glücklich wird diesen Plan nicht für ITT 2011 benötigt. Das Sportzentrum hat TAVERES erlaubt selbst das Frühstück zu versorgen weil Sie die Frühstück Aufbereitungsinfrastruktur nicht hin bekommen. Das heilige Ritual ist für 2011 sichergestellt aber wehr Weiß was die Zukunft bringt.

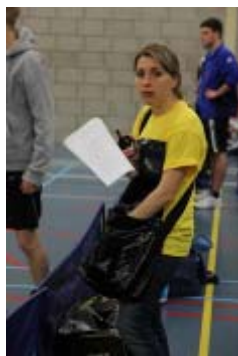
